



2025 - 2026 Student Supply List for 5th and 6th Grade

Here is a list of all the supplies you should bring to school on the first day of school.

ELA <ul style="list-style-type: none">• TBD
Math <ul style="list-style-type: none">• 1 Folder (any color except RED)• 1 spiral one subject notebook graph or line• One pack of thin black expo markers
STEM <ul style="list-style-type: none">• 1 Spiral notebook (college ruled) - STEM Notebook and name should be written on the front• Pack of glue sticks (at least 3)• Scissors• Students should be prepared to come to every class with a pencil, colored pencils/markers, glue stick, and scissors! Keep these items in a zippered pencil pouch.
Spanish <ul style="list-style-type: none">• 2 inch Binder• Spanish-English Dictionary (students should keep it at home)• 4 packs of Index Card (to create flash cards)• 1 pack of 3 hole punched of loose leaf lined paper• 1 set of 8 dividers (different colors with pocket)
Social Studies <ul style="list-style-type: none">• 1.5 inch binder, no larger (does NOT have to be a hard backed binder)- fifth graders can reuse the same binder again, with the same pockets• 1 pack of tabbed pocket dividers• 1 pack of index cards• 1-2 packs of loose leaf paper (leave one pack at home, and bring one to school)• Colored correcting pen(s)- NOT sharpies or highlighters• Binder hole punch (small one that goes into the binder, not a large desk hole punch)
Art <ul style="list-style-type: none">• 1 roll of Bounty paper towel (grade 5)• 1 roll of gray duct tape (grade 6)

Religion

- .5-1 inch binder
- Rosary beads

General

- **1-2 packs of sharpened pencils**
- Pens (red, blue, black)
- 4 boxes of tissues
- 2 Tubes of Lysol Wipes
- 1 roll of paper towels
